












The Four Purposes are at the heart of all we do and are the starting point of our curriculum design. Each mascot represents a purpose and their names have been inspired by the founder of our school.

This area of learning includes, geography, history, religion, values and ethics, business studies and social studies.








Science & Technology








Careers & Work
