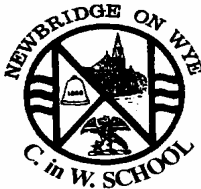

THE QUEEN'S GREEN CANOPY TREE OF TREES



As a result of our school's excellent community involvement and interest in the Queen's Green Canopy, the school has been successfully nominated by The Lord Lieutenant of Powys to receive a special tree to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. The school participated in the initiative, hoping to provide inspiration to create a greener UK in honour of the Queen's leadership of the nation.

The school was one of only two organisations in the County of Powys to be nominated and, as a result of the nomination, was presented with a tree from the "Tree of Trees"; a fantastic sculpture, the "Tree of Trees" featured 350 British native trees, which stood outside Buckingham Palace as an exciting centrepiece of The Queen's Platinum Jubilee weekend celebrations in June.

This presentation will now also be a memorial to the Queen and her wish that trees be planted to reflect her Jubilee milestone.

ATTENDANCE %	LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES	OUTCOME
95-100% attendance	Best chance of success	Your child is taking full advantage of every learning opportunity.
90-95% attendance	At least 2 weeks of learning missed	Satisfactory. Your child may have to spend time catching up with work.
85-90% attendance	At least 4 weeks of learning missed	Your child may be at risk of underachieving and may need extra support from you to catch up with work.
80-85% attendance	At least 5 ½ weeks of learning missed	Your child's poor attendance has a significant impact on learning.
Below 80% attendance	At least 7 ½ weeks of learning missed	Your child is missing out on a broad and balanced education. You are at risk of prosecution.
